NAHSE Baltimore Chapter is gearing up for its annual Summer Internship Program. Each year undergraduate and graduate students are placed into summer internships with health care organizations in the Baltimore Washington metropolitan area. Participating students have interests in health administration, public health, health information technology as well as business administration, finance, marketing, and human resources. The Chapter seeks to place these students in organizations that are willing to give them valuable and meaningful experiences in the health care industry. The program duration is eight (8) to ten (10) weeks, beginning in June.

Summer Internship Host Sites

In the past, students have been placed at a variety of sites including The Johns Hopkins Health System, Johns Hopkins International, University of Maryland Medical System, MedStar Health System, Bon Secours Baltimore Health System and Healthcare Resolution Services, Inc. (a healthcare information management consulting firm). This promises to be another exciting year as we add additional sponsoring institutions to our list.

The approximate cost to sponsor a summer intern, for the 8 - 10 week period, is \$5,000 for an undergraduate student and \$5,500 for a graduate student. This cost includes:

- Student stipend
- Administrative and program costs (i.e. student professional development sessions)
